




THINGS FOR KIDS TO KNOW:

Cell phone wall: has bright flashing lights.

Hint: Walk behind the screen in front of the exhibit to stay away from the lights.

Tesla Coil: makes a short loud noise and has a short bright flash of light every hour on the hour!

(11 AM, 12 noon, 1 PM, etc)

Hint: There is a staff member at this exhibit who will let you know before the noise and flash of light happen, so that you can leave the room if you wish.

Complete the Circuit: You will not get a shock when using this exhibit.

Hint: Hold the two balls that are connected by tubing to make this work.

Key: You will get an electric shock when you touch the key in this exhibit.

Hint: Use the potholder to touch the key to get a very small shock instead. There is a staff member here to help you.

Static Electricity: You will get a very small shock when you touch this exhibit.
