TELESCOPE

While there are many different kinds of telescopes observing all aspects of the cosmos, the massive Zeiss telescope found in The Franklin Institute's Joel N. Bloom Observatory is a refractor telescope. Refractors are the earliest form of optical telescope having first appeared in the early 1600s.
